The exhibition DIALOGUE is generated from the first project of international artist residency organized by ICBC Institute of Culture of Baja California, CEARTE State Center for the Arts Ensenada and Building Bridges Art Foundation as part of the international exchange created by these institutions in 2007. DIALOGUE has been designed and conceptualized from the residency program as a platform for cultural exchange and for the integration, training and reflection of the audience. This exhibition explores the imagery of each artist's identity, their countries and cultures.
